## A NOTE FROM FR LARRY

I'm writing this note on Tuesday evening, March 14, which is the second evening of our Parish Lenten Mission led by Fr. James Hederman, S.J.. It has been a great experience thus far. Fr. Hederman, who grew up in Holy Name and is an expert in the Spirituality of Jesuit Founder St. Ignatius of Loyola, has been helping us learn and practice "Guided Meditation" and "The Examen", two powerful forms of Ignatian prayer. Attendance has been excellent, despite the wintery weather. We're looking forward to Wednesday evening's closing Mass.

This Sunday, March 19, will be the Fourth Sunday of Lent, also known as Laetare Sunday, a title based on the Latin for the first word of the Entrance Antiphon: "Rejoice". We've reached the mid-point in Lent and the Church briefly looks forward to the joy of Easter. It's one of only two Sundays each year that priests and deacons can wear rose-colored vestments (a combination of the violet of Lent and the white of Easter). Please note the hours (2-4 and 6-9 p.m.) for Confession on Reconciliation Monday, April 3, and please make a good Confession during Lent.

March 19 is also the day of the Park Slope Brooklyn St. Patrick's Parade, with the pre-parade Mass being celebrated by Bishop Octavio Cisneros in Holy Name Church at 10:30 a.m. Please see the flyer on Page 6 of this bulletin. Congratulations again to all Honorees!

Those of you who attended the 10:30 a.m. Mass on March 12, or will attend the 5:30 p.m. Vigil Masses on Saturday, March 18, and Saturday, March 25, noticed or will notice a difference from other Masses: After the homily at each of those three Masses, we celebrated, or will celebrate, the First, Second and Third Scrutinies of Nataly Castillo, the participant in our Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) program who will receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist and Confirmation at our Easter Vigil. The Scrutinies are ancient rites. As their name suggests, they used to involve an examination of those who were preparing to receive the Sacraments for the first time. They now focus more on prayer for the new Sacrament-recipients, and serve as an invitation for them to "scrutinize" their progress on their faith journeys as they move closer to the Lord through the Church and the Church's Sacraments. The rest of us present at those Masses were, or will be, invited to pray for Nataly, our new Sacrament-recipient. We'll also be invited to scrutinize ourselves regarding our fidelity to the Sacraments of Initiation

(Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation) that most of us were blessed to receive much earlier in our lives. We should ask ourselves how well we are living up to the promises we—or more likely, our parents and godparents—made at our Baptisms. Even if you were not / are not present for the Scrutinies at Mass, the invitation to self-scrutinize is something each of us can benefit from as we complete Lent and look forward to renewing our Baptismal promises on Easter Sunday. We pray for Nataly in her final weeks of preparation, and we again thank her OCIA instructor, Deacon Gerry Devine.

Please make a pledge to the 2023 Annual Catholic Appeal as part of your Lenten Almsgiving. The Diocese is urging us to make as much progress as possible during Lent on this important initiative. As you know, the ACA provides critical assistance to many people and programs throughout the Diocese. It also provides critical support to Holy Name Parish since all dollars donated above the Diocesan goal are returned to the Parish where we use them to help reduce our debt. Thank you for your generosity.

## EVERYDAY DISCIPLESHIP

Talking about discipleship and truly being a disciple are two very different things. It is easier to know what we should do than to carry out. Many saints from our tradition have had much to say about this struggle to do what they know they must do, and not do that which they know they shouldn't. It is part of being human.

Without God, we have no chance to overcome this predicament. Without God, our actions can ring hollow, or often we are too immobilized to act at all. Without God, we suffer with blindness to the truth of what is important and eternal.

The story in John 9 of Jesus healing the blind man is about more than a physical healing and just one man. It is about how each of us can find healing of our blindness by turning to Jesus Christ. Are you someone that has been saying, "I don't understand all this talk of discipleship and stewardship; what's the big deal?" We all have a blindness that needs to be healed, and the body of Christ needs you so that God's presence in our world can be seen in a more profound manner. The reality is that God heals the blindness of those who seek him so that, in turn, they may be vehicles by which others may see as well.

This Lent, you are invited to bring your blindness to Jesus. All the written reflections in the world will not give you new eyes. Those eyes can only be found in Jesus.


