## 2023 DIOCESAN LENTEN PILGRIMAGE DIOCESE OF BROOKLYN

As part of the Eucharistic Revival, and a direct result of the Synod meetings that began in 2021, the Diocese of Brooklyn invites all the faithful to participate in a pilgrimage to parishes throughout our Diocese during the 2023 Lenten season. There's no need to walk through the boroughs; you can get to each Church by car or public transportation.

On each of the 40 days of Lent (excluding Sundays) you'll have the opportunity to spend time with the Lord at a different Church. The Pilgrimage began in the Cathedral Basilica of St. James on Ash Wednesday and will continue to wend its way through Brooklyn and Queens until it reaches Holy Cross in Maspeth on Wednesday, April 5. The final "stops"—Holy Thursday through Easter Sunday—will be in your home parish.

At each stop, pilgrims can attend Mass, receive reconciliation, or engage in Eucharistic Adoration and quiet reflection. You can also have your passport affixed with the "stamp" of that parish. Securing 20 or more stamps qualifies each passport holder for a special certificate signed by Bishop Brennan.

# A NOTE FROM FR LARRY

Lent has begun! In Holy Name of Jesus Parish, our Small Faith Sharing Groups are meeting and our Monday Evening Holy Hours and other parish Lenten Devotions are underway. In furtherance of the National Eucharistic Revival, the Brooklyn Diocese has organized a “Diocesan Lenten Pilgrimage” that offers a special opportunity for Mass and an extended period of Eucharistic Adoration in a different parish church in the Diocese on each day of Lent.

There is more information about various Lenten devotions in this bulletin. I particularly want to remind you that Fr. James Hederman, SJ, who grew up in HNJ parish and is a frequent visitor back to our Church for various events, will give a three-day Lenten Mission here on the evenings of Monday, March 13 through Wednesday, March 15. He has worked in Jesuit High Schools for over 30 years, and has been with Xavier HS in Manhattan for the past 11 years. Fr. Hederman has done retreat work and spiritual guidance in the mode of St. Ignatius’ of Loyola Spiritual Exercises across the United States and internationally. In bringing that expertise to HNJ for our annual Lenten Mission, Fr. Hederman is offering what will be a unique experience for many of us. For those who can’t participate in one or more of the evening sessions, I will offer the same topics on the following mornings, after the 9 a.m. Masses. Please see the flyer on Page 6 of this bulletin for more details.

At our 10:30 Mass last Sunday, we had the rite of “sending forth” our catechumen, Nataly Castillo, to the “Rite of Election” held at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church later that evening. Nataly is preparing to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation at the Easter Vigil. On Sunday evening, Nataly joined several hundred other catechumens, all of whom were welcomed by our Diocesan Bishop Brennan as they became members of “the elect” which is the next stage in their progress towards reception of the sacraments of initiation at Easter. Congratulations to Nataly and many thanks to our Deacon Gerry Devine, her instructor and guide.

Last Sunday, we also announced the beginning of the 2023 Annual Catholic Appeal. As you know, the ACA provides critical assistance to many people and programs throughout the Diocese. It also provides critical support to HNJ parish since all dollars donated above

the Diocesan goal are returned to the parish where we use them to reduce our debt. Please make a pledge to the ACA as part of your Lenten Almsgiving.

Also, please continue to pray for peace in the Ukraine and for all those who died in, or are suffering because of, the earthquakes in Turkey and Syria. †

## Looking More Closely at the Word

As a kid I remember looking at my sister and thinking, "No man is ever going to marry her. She is way too...my sister!" I couldn't see her as anything except my goofy, emotional, cooties-laden sister. Years later, on her wedding day, I remember seeing how her husband looked at her, he was totally in love with her, his watery eyes full of overwhelmed joy, drinking in her beauty and grace. He was the one who actually saw her. Blinded by familiarity, I had not been able to see her until now. She was glorious. I finally saw how beautiful my sister really was.

Jesus is transfigured before Peter, James, and John. His face shone like the sun and his clothes dazzle with heavenly light. If it's a miracle, it is so related to the apostles' perception of the glory of Jesus. The physical spectacle reveals how the Father perceives the Son, so to speak: "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well-pleased; listen to him." The Son is always bathed in the Father's love. It's only just now that they finally perceive it.

Who could possibly give his or her heart totally to Jesus? If we perceive him to be just another teacher, symbol, or moral example, we can't. But if the Holy Spirit gives us eyes to see that he is the Beloved Son of God, who makes our humanity not just pleasing to God but filled with glory ... then who can resist him? Perhaps only the lovers are the ones who properly see.

None of us is perfect, and all of us carry burdens that could be lightened through honest reflection and repentance. Other religions include a confessional practice as well, attesting to the universal need: Jews confess "We have sinned" in the Yom Kippur service. Confession is part of the Hindu Prāyaścitta. In Islam, the act of seeking forgiveness from God for sins is called Istighfar. Buddhist monks confess their sins to other monks. Check the bulletin, and find time for Confession. 
