A NOTE FROM FR LARRY

Last Sunday, June 11, was the **Solemnity of the of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ (Corpus Christi)**. It is a Solemnity traditionally observed by the celebration of Mass and a Eucharistic Procession, and I had the privilege of participating in three processions. The first was after our 10:30 a.m. Mass here at Holy Name. The second was a multi-parish procession later Sunday at Our Lady of Peace Church on Carroll Street. The third was a procession and Mass for the students and teachers of our aligned St. Joseph the Worker Catholic Academy (SJWCA) on June 14. All three processions were great public demonstrations of our belief as Catholics in the Real Presence of the entirety of Jesus Christ – Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity – in the Eucharist.

June 11 was also the beginning of the second year of the **National Eucharistic Revival**. One of the most important events of this second year will be a Diocesan celebration on Saturday, October 7, at Maimonides Park (Cyclones Stadium) in Coney Island. Planning is underway for other events at the parish level. There is still much to come during the Revival.

Last Saturday evening, **HNJ's Cub Scout Pack 237** had its annual Camp Fire/Awards ceremony, and its overnight camp out in Our Lady's Field. They also attended the 7:30 Mass on Sunday morning. It was my privilege to offer a blessing at the campfire, to congratulate the award recipients, and to thank the adult Scout leaders for the time they devote all year to make Scouting possible here at HNJ.

Last Sunday was the close of our 2022/2023 **Religious Education (Sunday School, CCD) Program**. I want to thank our Coordinator of Religious Education, Kathryn Sisto, and our catechists for their dedication in teaching our children in non-Catholic schools about our faith and preparing them to receive the Sacraments. Registration remains open for the 2022/2023 semester.

This is **Graduation Week** for the Eighth-grade students at **SJWCA**, with the Graduation Mass on June 15 and the Graduation itself on June 16. The graduates' names will appear in next week's bulletin, but we offer advance congratulations to them, their families and loved ones, SJWCA Academy Principal Stephanie Germann, Board Chair Christopher Artz, and the faculty and staff.


This Sunday, June 18, is also **Father's Day** and we will have a special blessing at each of the Masses.

Happy Father's Day to all fathers, grandfathers, godfathers, uncles and all those men who assist in the role of father in our children's lives.

The still-new Federal Holiday of **Juneteenth** (also known as "Freedom Day") will be observed on Monday, June 19. It commemorates the liberation on June 19, 1865 (two and a half years after the Emancipation Proclamation!) of the last group of African Americans enslaved by the Confederacy. We will offer prayers appropriate to the Holiday (especially prayers for a reduction in division and gun violence in our great country) at our 9 a.m. Mass. The Rectory Office will be closed for the Holiday

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops has designated June 22 through June 29 as **Religious Freedom Week**. The USCCB reminds us that this is a week when "the faithful can promote the essential right of religious freedom for Catholics and for those of all faiths." The week begins with the Memorial of St. Thomas Moore, a distinguished lay lawyer and martyr for religious freedom. Please see the flyer on page 6 of this bulletin announcing that Fr. John Cush will lead a showing and discussion of the Academy Award winning film "A Man For All Seasons", which is about the life and death of St. Thomas Moore. **Fr.
