A NOTE FROM FR. LARRY

Confirmation: Congratulations to the young people who received Confirmation in Holy Name Church last Friday. Their names are listed below, with Confirmation names in red. Congratulations and thanks also to their parents, other family members, sponsors, teachers, and the catechists who helped them reach this important day in their spiritual lives. Special thanks to Bishop James Massa; our Coordinator of Religious Education, Kathryn Sisto; our Director of Music, Ivonne Rojas; and the many other people who helped make this such a beautiful liturgy.

Vocation Awareness: November 5-11 is National Vocation Awareness Week. It is certainly a time when we should all pray for vocations to the priesthood, diaconate and consecrated religious life. It is also a time when young people (and people not so young!) are reminded to ask themselves the question: “Am I being called to serve as a priest, a deacon, or a religious sister or brother?” We are certain that God has not stopped calling people to those vocations. The problem is that people are not responding to His call. The vocation call often begins as something very small. To anyone who feels even a slight call to or interest in these vocations, some recommended first steps include more frequent attendance at Mass, reception of the Holy Eucharist, and prayer (especially prayer before the Blessed Sacrament and prayers to our Blessed Mother). If the call to, or interest in, these vocations continues (even slightly, remembering that this a gradual process), a recommended next step would be to speak to a priest, a deacon, or a religious sister or brother who can give you additional

guidance. At that early stage, you will not be asked to make any commitments. Please do not ignore what might be a vocational call. Bishop Brennan’s Prayer For Vocations, and contact information for the Brooklyn Diocese’s Vocation Office, appear on the next page. Our Eucharistic Revival Holy Hour at 7 p.m. on Friday, November 17 will include prayers for vocations.

Veterans Day: Friday, November 11 is Veterans Day, a day when we remember the millions of veterans who served on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States during times of war or armed conflict. At our 9 a.m. Mass, we will pray for all veterans, as well as for the specific Mass intention. There are historical and current connections between the members of the U.S. Armed Forces and the Catholic religious and clergy who minister to them, to their dependents, and especially to those in Veterans Hospitals. God bless all our veterans (in particular, those from our own Parish!) as well as all Catholic priests, deacons and religious brothers/sisters who have ministered to them and continue to do so.

November, the Month of All Souls: Here in HNJ Parish during November, we will remember the souls of the faithfully departed in several ways. By the time you read this bulletin, we will have already celebrated Masses for all the faithfully departed, and especially for those whose Funeral Masses were celebrated in HNJ Church during the past year. Your All Souls envelopes will remain on the altar throughout the month. May the souls of all the faithful departed rest in peace, Amen. ✚
